Answer:

This response is based on 28 February 2014 data due to data extraction limitations of the payroll system.

As at 28 February 2014 the Australian Public Service Commission employed 235.72 FTE employees.

- (a) Of these employees, 216.53 are ongoing; and
- (b) 19.19 are non-ongoing.
