What is the total cost of media monitoring services provided to the department/agency since 18 September 2013? Please provide details of (a) the service provider and (b) the cost. Are media monitoring services purchased by the department/agency provided to the office of a Minister or Parliamentary Secretary? If so, please provide details of the service, including, if applicable, any additional costs incurred by the department/agency.

**Answer:**

(a) The media monitoring service is provided by iSentia Pty Ltd

(b) The cost of the media monitoring service from 18 September 2013 to 28 February 2014 was \$20,358 exclusive of GST.
