- (1) What is the total cost expended on stationery since 31 October 2013? Is stationery purchased by the department/agency provided to the office of a Minister or Parliamentary Secretary? If so, please provide details of the stationery, including the total cost by Minister or Parliamentary Secretary?

**Answer:**

- (1) The financial management information system used by the Office can only provide this data on a monthly basis. Since 1 November 2013 to 28 February 2014, the total cost expended by the Office on stationery was \$2,880.79.
