Budget Estimates 2004-05 - May 2004

Questions on Notice from Senator Andrew Murray:

Please provide a list of all advertising or public information projects currently being undertaken or expected to be undertaken by the department or agency in the course of 2004 where the cost of the project is estimated or contracted to be \$100 000 or more, indicating:

- (a) the purpose and nature of the project;
- (b) the intended recipients of the information to be communicated by the project;
 - (c) who authorised or is to authorise the project;
 - (d) the manner in which the project is to be carried out;
 - (e) who is to carry out the project;
 - (f) whether the project is to be carried out under a contract;
 - (g) whether such contract was let by tender;
 - (h) the estimated or contracted cost of the project.

Answer: The Department of Parliamentary Services has no advertising or public information projects being undertaken, or expecting to be undertaken during 2004 with a value in excess of \$100,000.
