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**SENATOR MOORE** asked the Minister for Human Services, upon written notice:

Mr Bashford—I think there is a law that says that we have to keep those records for a period of time.

Senator MOORE—Can I put that on notice in terms of what would be the lifespan of documentation and ID?

Mr Bashford—Yes.

#### **Answer:**

How long documentation collected at registration, including identity documentation, is kept is a matter for decision by government.
