Senator Ludwig asked:

The following questions by Senator Ludwig relate to the purchase of executive coaching and/or other leadership training services by the department/agency, broken down for each of the last four financial years.

Where available, please provide:

- (1) Total spending on these services
- (2) The number of employees offered these services and their salary level
- (3) The number of employees who have utilised these services and their salary level
- (4) The names of all the service providers engaged
- (5) For each service purchased from a provider listed in the answer to the previous question, please provide:
 - a. The name and nature of the service purchased
 - b. Whether the services is one-on-one or group based
 - c. The number of employees who received the service
 - d. The total number of hours involved for all employees
 - e. The total amount spent on the service
 - f. A description of the fees charged (eg. per hour, complete package)
 - Where a service was provided at any location other than the department or agency's own premises, please provide:
 - i. The location used
 - ii. The number of employees who took part on each occasion
 - iii. The total number of hours involved for all involved who took part.

Answer:
