SENATOR WONG asked on 24/05/2007:

Ms Hartland—We are very happy to table those. The initial lot of information took the form of a small pamphlet that went out to people, advertising in newspapers and things, which I am happy to detail.

Senator WONG—So what exactly are you tabling—examples or the totality?

Ms Hartland—We will table the pamphlets that went out so that you can see the broad pieces of information that are in there. The information awareness program comprised broadcast and print material that went out. It was about raising awareness about the card and to keep people informed about the progress of the card. Print and radio ads were placed in metropolitan, suburban, regional, non-English-speaking background and Indigenous media. I have a list of those, if that would be helpful.

WHAT IS THE CARD?

Australians have a world class health and social services system. To keep it that way, the Australian Government must continually make improvements. For this reason, we are proposing to introduce a single card for people to receive health and social services.

- The card could replace up to 17 existing cards, including your:
- Medicare card
 - Centrelink benefit and concession cards
 - Veterans' cards.

It will be part of a secure system which provides benefits for you, and the community as a whole.

The card will be available to people over 18 – or younger if needed – who are eligible for health, veterans' and social services provided by the Australian Government. Existing entitlements will remain the same.

Children will be included on their parents' cards, in a similar way to the current Medicare card. It is proposed to gradually introduce the card from 2008.

HOW WILL IT WORK?

The card will be your key to receiving Australian Government health and social services. You will need to present your card when dealing with an agency or provider of these services. Beyond that, it will not be compulsory to carry or show the card.

It is proposed that your card will have printed on it your name, your photo, your signature, the card number and expiry date.

To make the system more secure, and to protect your privacy and identity, a microchip will also be included on the card. The chip is expected to include your name, address, digitised photo and signature, card number, expiry date, gender, concession status and your PIN. If you have children, their details will be included on your card's chip.

No financial information or your Tax File Number will be on the card, on the chip or held by the registration service. There will be no change to your existing entitlements.

HOW WILL THE CARD BENEFIT YOU?

- The card will benefit you by:
- better protecting your identity
 - restricting access to your information
 - allowing you to customise certain aspects of your card to your needs
 - reducing health and social service fraud
 - improving services to you.

BETTER PROTECTION OF YOUR IDENTITY

You will only have to register once.

To get your card you will need to prove who you are.

We will let you know closer to registration in 2008 what you will have to do. It will be a convenient yet thorough process to ensure people can get only one card. As your card is unique to you, it will help protect your identity from being misused if your card is stolen or lost.

The system will use advanced and proven security technologies. This will be a significant improvement on the magnetic strip and cardboard cards in use today.



RESTRICTING ACCESS TO YOUR INFORMATION

Your personal information will be protected by legislation. There will be strict controls over how agency staff can view your information and all access will be logged and audited.

Unlike your driver's licence, which has most of your personal details clearly visible, the new card will securely store most of your information on the chip.

What is stored on the chip will be kept on the registration service.

There will be no single database holding all your health and social services details. Your agency-specific information will stay where it currently is – with that agency. So when you present your card to our staff, they will only see the information which is relevant to the services that agency delivers.

CUSTOMISING ASPECTS OF YOUR CARD

You will have the choice to customise the card to suit your needs, by adding information about yourself or your dependants. This information will be stored securely on the chip and could include:

- emergency contact details
- allergies
- organ donor status
- date of birth.

If you are a carer, or are cared for by another person, this information could also be stored on your card's chip.

Veterans

If you are a veteran you can customise the colour of your card depending on your existing eligibility. For example, Gold Card veterans will be able to have a gold coloured card if they wish.
