## SENATOR SIEWERT asked on 24/05/2007:

- 1. How many people receiving 8 week non-payment periods have been offered case management?
- 2. How many of those have accepted case management?
- 3. Of those offered case management how many had dependent children and how many were considered "exceptionally vulnerable"?
- 4. How many people who have received financial case management are Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people?

## Answer:

- 1. As at 1 June 2007, 1,000 job seekers serving an eight-week non-payment period had been offered Financial Case Management.
- 2. As at 1 June 2007, 772 job seekers had accepted the offer of Financial Case Management.
- 3. As at 1 June 2007, of the 1,000 job seekers offered Financial Case Management, 928 were parents and 72 were assessed as being exceptionally vulnerable.
- 4. As at 1 June 2007, 65 job seekers who identify as being Indigenous have received payments through Financial Case Management.
