## **SENATOR STOTT DESPOJA asked** on 24/05/2007:

**Senator STOTT DESPOJA**—That is right—I have it [HS 7] on computer but not on hard copy—comparable mass storage of biometric photographs. I am just a bit concerned about the response given...

Now, I just wonder whether you are still comfortable with that answer you provided to me. I understand that there is a distinction between smartcard technology and the biometric facial recognition. But that is what I wanted, that is what I was interested in, and I am not comfortable that that is reflected in the answer from the department.

**Ms Hartland**—We will have to go back and seek some specific advice on those.

#### **Answer:**

The Department of Human Services' response in HS7 (February 2007 Additional Estimates) incorrectly included Taiwan in the list of facial biometric data matching systems. This was in fact a successful smart card implementation project. The remaining examples are correct.
