#### **Senator Coonan asked:**

I want to deal with Mr Tanner's budget efficiencies. He nominated \$1 billion of efficiencies achieved in the 2009-10 budget, because \$4 billion was obviously from last year's budget even though he ran it together. Can Finance provide a breakdown of the \$1 billion of efficiencies from government operations?

#### **Answer:**

The Minister for Finance and Deregulation issued a press release on 12 May 2009 (28/2009) advising that the 2009-10 Budget would deliver an additional \$1.1 billion in savings over four years in the operation of government.

These savings measures relate to a range of strategies including streamlining administrative arrangements, reducing the level of promotional activities and removing duplicated management processes for some programs.

A breakdown of the savings is provided below (reporting total savings in each case for the four years from 2009-10).
