## **Answer:**

No, the Department does not collect information about the relative position of the Commonwealth Government in terms of advertising spending. However, the May 2010 *Monthly AdEX Summary Highlights Report,* produced by the Nielson Company, details media expenditure data for major advertisers. The latest report ranks the Australian Government as number eight in terms of free to air television media expenditure for calendar year to date.
