- a) Have any of the Prime Minister's staff taken stress leave?
- b) How many people in the Office of the Prime Minister have had their employment terminated?
- c) How many staff does the Prime Minister have based in
 - (i) Canberra; and,
 - (ii) Brisbane?
- d) How many staff have left the employment of the Office of the Prime Minister since December 2007?

Answer (all responses relate to the office of the former Prime Minister, the Hon Kevin Rudd MP as at 25 May 2010):

- a) No person employed in the former Prime Minister's Office specified "stress" as the reason for leave.
- b) No employee in the former Prime Minister's Office was terminated.
- c) Of the personal staff employed in the former Prime Minister's Office at 25 May 2010:
 - (i) 43 staff had a work base in Canberra
 - (ii) 2 staff had a work base in Brisbane.
- d) Between 3 December 2007 and 25 May 2010, 42 staff left employment in the former Prime Minister's Office. This includes resignations, transfers between offices and the end of non-ongoing contracts.
