- 1. Have staffing numbers been reduced as a result of the efficiency dividend and/or other budget cuts?

## Answer:

- 1. The Office manages its operations within the resources provided by Government through budget processes. The Office has reduced staffing levels by around 14 per cent over the past 3 years through natural attrition as part of a package of efficiency measures.
- 2. Reductions in staff numbers have occurred at various levels throughout the organisation as a result of natural attrition.
- 3. Any further reductions in staff numbers would be considered on a case-by-case basis as a result of natural attrition.
- 4. No changes are underway or planned in relation to graduate recruitment, cadetships or similar programs.
