Question:

- 1. What is the governance relationship between the Commission and the Department?
- 2. How independent will the Commission be?
- 3. How much funding is available for the Commission?
- 4. How will members be appointed?

Answer:

- 1. The National Mental Health Commission (NMHC) will be governed by a Chief Executive Officer and will report to an agency minister within the Prime Minister's portfolio.
- 2. The NMHC will be proposed to the Governor-General for establishment as an Executive Agency under section 65 of the *Public Service Act 1999*. The operation of the NMHC will be independent from the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet. The NMHC will have financial and staffing autonomy.
- 3. In total, \$32 million over five years has been allocated for the establishment and activities of the NMHC.
- 4. The Mental Health Commissioners will be appointed by the agency minister.
