Senator IAN MACDONALD: The Western Australian government's contribution

was for hard infrastructure in channels, roads and in the opening up of new land. Do

you have knowledge of how that project is going, or is that something that the

Western Australian government keeps to itself?

Ms Fleming: I could take that on notice and update for you on the Ord expansion.

Answer:

The WA Government advises that Phase One, which delivers 19km of new arterial

irrigation channel, control structures, storm water drains and 14 km of new road is

about 80 per cent complete. It is estimated that Phase One will be completed in three

months.

Phase Two of the project is the subject of an Environmental Impact Statement

Assessment required under the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation

Act 1999 (the EPBC Act).

The Phase Two construction contract and commencement of works is expected to

progress once this Assessment process is completed. The WA Government and the

contractor are in commercial negotiations.

The WA Government's current financial commitment to the project is \$220 million.
