- 1. How much has been spent under the Regional and Local Community Infrastructure program?
- 2. What does that work out as on an annual basis?
- 3. How much is the Regional Development Australia Fund spending on an annual basis on regional infrastructure projects?

Answer:

1. The original RLCIP was funded at \$300 million in 2008-09. The funding was subsequently complemented with an additional: \$500 million for 2008-09 and 2009-10; \$220 million for 2009-10 and 2010-11; and \$100 million for 2010-11 to meet the Government's global financial crisis response.

As at 30 June 2011, \$1,031.8 billion has been spent under the RLCIP.

2. By financial year, the Department has expended under the RLCIP the following amounts:

2008-09: \$479.9m

2009-10: \$331.9m

2010-11: \$220.0m
