## **Question:**

**Senator CORMANN:** Why is it that press releases from the finance minister are generally available much more slowly than press releases from the Treasury ministers?

...

**Senator Wong:** Senator, can I finish, please. My recollection is that we have set up our media list distribution through the Parliament House network, not the finance network. This is from the office. Is that right?

**Mr Murphy:** I think that is correct.

**Senator Wong:** In part that is because we do use my electorate office, for example, for transcription more than the previous finance minister did—which ensures a saving, you should be pleased to know—and that there was a problem with the Parliament House network on that day. But can I take that on notice and we will check it.

## **Answer:**

As discussed during the hearing, the Minister's office distributes media materials through the Parliament House email network, not the Department of Finance and Deregulation email network.
