Senator RONALDSON: How many of those substandard images were printed?

Mr Miles: I am not sure that I have that information. I can take it on notice. It was not a huge quantity—we were aware that it was a stopgap.

Senator RONALDSON: Can you also provide me with the cost of printing those inferior portraits, and can you tell me what happened to the ones that were not sent out—so I need how many were sent out and how many were retained by the department.

Mr Miles: Certainly.

Answer:

1,000 copies of the official Diamond Jubilee Portrait of Queen Elizabeth II and 1,000 copies of the official Diamond Jubilee Portrait of Queen Elizabeth II and Duke of Edinburgh image were printed.

The total cost of the printing was \$878.00 GST exclusive.

674 copies were ordered of the official Diamond Jubilee Portrait of Queen Elizabeth II, with 326 retained by the Department. 644 copies were ordered of the official Diamond Jubilee Portrait of Queen Elizabeth II and Duke of Edinburgh, with 356 retained by the Department.
