ONA Response:

The Office of National Assessments does not normally print any hard copies of reports/ statements/ papers for formal delivery to entities external to the APS, such as the annual report.

In November 2012, a one off monograph: *Robert Marsden Hope Building – A History* was printed by the Office of National Assessments commemorating the official opening; 250 copies of the booklet were handed out free to attendees and provided as a reference to the National Library of Australia and the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet library, at an estimated cost of \$500.
