 - What is the cost for this financial year to date?

Answer:

1. There has been no change to the TV subscription since the 2011-12 February Additional Estimates. The cost for TV subscription for this financial year to date is \$4,263 exclusive of GST.
2. There has been no change to the newspaper subscription since the 2011-12 February Additional Estimates.
3. There has been no change to the magazine subscription since the 2011-12 February Additional Estimates.

The subscription costs for newspapers and magazines are not separately recorded by the Australian Public Service Commission. The total cost of subscription for this financial year to date is \$8,396 exclusive of GST.
