# **Question:**

Are you going to go city by city? Will you just note the existence of the report? What can we expect to see by way of response from COAG?

On 13 April 2012, COAG considered the COAG Reform Council's (CRC) report Review of capital city strategic planning systems and agreed that continued intergovernmental collaboration, including further work on cities, be taken forward by the Standing Council on Transport and Infrastructure (SCOTI).
