## Answer:

- a) ComSuper has spent \$1,380,213 on legal services within the agency, between 1 July 2012 and 30 April 2013. For privacy reasons a list of legal services with respect to specific disputes with members and costs is not provided.
- b) ComSuper has spent \$146,253 on legal services with the Australian Government Solicitor (AGS), between 1 July 2012 and 30 April 2013. There was a further \$231,913 spent on legal services from the AGS from the Administered Legal Expenditure from the Consolidated Revenue Fund (CRF). This was for ComSuper's administration of superannuation schemes that apply to current and former Australian Government civilian employees and Australian Defence Force (ADF) members. Legal advice is sought as

required by the *Legal Services Directions 2005* and principally in relation to disputes that arise with members concerning their superannuation benefits and entitlements and appeals to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal, the Superannuation Complaints Tribunal or the Federal Court. The total sum being spent on legal services from AGS was \$378,166.

c) ComSuper has spent \$12,184 on legal services from external legal providers other than the AGS, between 1 July 2012 and 30 April 2013. There was a further \$70,323 spent on legal services from legal providers other than the AGS from the Administered Legal Expenditure from the CRF. The total sum being spent on legal services from private firms was \$82,507.
