#### **Answer**

- a) The following pay TV channels are provided free of charge to DPS for distribution throughout Parliament House:
  - SKY Business Channel
  - SKY News
  - CNN International
  - BBC World
  - CNBC Australia
  - Al Jazeera
  - A-PAC
  - Bloomberg
  - Fox Sports 1, 2 and 3
  - Fox News
  - Sky News Weather

The programs provide Senators, Members of the House of Representatives, their staff and staff of parliamentary departments with access to the content of publicly broadcast TV, current affairs programs, documentaries and other programs of interest that relate to their parliamentary and representational duties.

b) The Parliamentary Library subscribes to hardcopy regional, national and overseas newspapers for use by Senators and Members and their staff, as well as Library and other DPS officers. This supports the provision of information, analysis and advice to Senators and Members and their staff.

Online newspapers are also available through Factiva, Library Press Display and ANZ Newsstand.

As at 31 March 2013, the Library had spent \$50,224.98 this financial year on newspaper subscriptions (International \$7,347 and Australian \$42,877.98).

c) The Parliamentary Library subscribes to 2949 print and 23,099 electronic magazines/journals (serials) for use by Senators and Members and their staff, and to support the provision of information, analysis and advice to Senators and Members and their staff. These titles are listed in the Library's catalogue; it is not practicable to include a full list of these titles here.

Additionally, DPS work areas sometime require magazine subscriptions to assist with their operational activities (e.g. technical manuals). These resources are classified as working tools and, although managed by the Parliamentary Library, are paid by the user areas.

Magazines/journals for the Parliamentary Library collections are purchased by annual subscription. As at 31 March 2013, the Library had spent \$1,092,466.80 this financial year on such subscriptions.

DPS had expended a further \$7,031.64 on magazines/journals and newspapers.
