- - a. What are the details of the department/agency electricity purchasing agreement?
 - b. What are the department/agency electricity costs for this financial year to date?

Answer

a) Electricity for Parliament House is supplied through a Whole-of-Government (WoG) contract, which commenced on 1 July 2011. Price Schedules are Commercial-in-Confidence. The previous supply contract was a WoG agreement, with ActewAGL as the supplier.

The current electricity supplier to Parliament House is ERM Power Retail Pty Ltd.

ERM Power is a publicly listed company and is both a power generator and retail provider. The WoG contract with the Commonwealth commenced in July 2011 for 4 years.

b) Electricity cost for this financial year to 31 March 2013 is \$2,971,327 ex-GST.
