ONA Response:

Yes, automatic coffee machines: 2 on 29 /9/11 for \$\$3,968 each; 1 on 19/5/10 for \$3,734; 1 on 31/5/10 for \$3,895. Purchases of coffee and cleaning products in FY 2011-12 cost \$6,683.

Why were coffee machines purchased?

ONA Response:

To encourage staff not to discuss ONA business over coffee in unsecure environments.

Question:

Has there been a noticeable difference in staff productivity since coffee machines were purchased? Are staff leaving the office premises less during business hours as a result?

ONA Response:

Some staff still choose to use external coffee outlets. However, usage of the machines provided by ONA still represents a productivity dividend of over 90 hours per week.
