1. List:
 - a) all consultants used;
 - b) total amount spent;
 - c) reason for each project;
 - d) whether each project was tendered, if so provide details of tender process.
2. For each of the projects provide
 - a) outcomes of the project;
 - b) recommendations of the project;
 - c) in depth detail of the purpose of the project?
3. For each project, provide dates that the consultancies were paid?
4. For each project, what action has followed as a result of any recommendations?
5. For each project, provide a copy of all consultants' reports?
6. For each project provide a copy of the tender document?

Answer:

Medicare Australia's systems for reporting on consultancy contracts are designed to satisfy the reporting requirements in the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet's Annual Report guidelines.

Consistent with these guidelines, specific information about new consultancy contracts is detailed in Medicare Australia's Annual Report 2004-05 at page 214.

The provision of information on consultancies in addition to the comprehensive data already included in the Annual Report would entail the diversion of a large amount of resources and this diversion can not be justified.
