Mr Murtagh of the Office of the Official Secretary stated specifically that no new clothing had been provided to the Governor-General to date in answer to my question of 20 October 2008. In a letter received by the Finance and Public Administration Committee on 22 October 2008, Mr Mrdak stated that the Governor-General receives a one-off fitting-out (or clothing) allowance.

Could the Department please outline whether the provision of any military uniform for the Governor-General for official purposes is included in this allowance or whether that would be a separate allocation of funds?

Inform the committee whether a request has been made by the Governor-General for the provision of a military uniform?
