I am interested to know whether Finance has commissioned any monitoring system to scrutinise consultancy expenditure across government.

## Answer:

Finance has not commissioned a monitoring system to scrutinise consultancy expenditure across the government.

However, as per the *Requirements for Annual Reports*, released by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet and approved by the Joint Committee of Public Accounts and Audit under subsection 63(2) and 70(2) of the *Public Service Act 1999*, all agencies are currently required to report the total number and the total expenditure for all new and on-going consultancies for a financial year within their annual reports.
