- c) Has electoral specific data been used by the current Government in any grants scheme since November 2007?

#### **Answer:**

- a) Electorate briefs are prepared for use by the Prime Minister on an 'as required' basis. There is no intention to publish them as they are prepared for the personal use of the Prime Minister as she visits an electorate.
- b) The Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (PM&C) did not prepare any electorate briefs in the period from the commencement of the caretaker period on 19 July to the 2010 election on 21 August.
