- 3. A total of 27 temporary positions existed or were created in the period 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2011.
- 4. There were 42 people employed on contract under the *Public Service Act 1999* to fill both temporary and permanent positions on a temporary basis for the period 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2011, with an average employment period of 201 calendar days.
