## **Question:**

Are there any plans for staff reduction? If so, please advise details ie. Reduction target, how this will be achieved, services/programs to be cut etc.

If there are plans for staff reductions, please give the reason why these are happening.

## **Answer:**

To ensure that it maintains a balanced budget, the OAIC may need to reduce staff numbers in 2012–13 and 2013–14. Initial estimates are that six APS 6 positions may be required. The OAIC will monitor staffing and budget closely, and plans to manage any required reduction through attrition.
