For the month of June 2011, the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet (PM&C) spent \$13,184.61 (GST inclusive) on official hospitality. Details are provided at <u>Attachment A</u>. In the rare case that entertainment costs are incurred by PM&C on department functions, these costs are not recorded separately. Official hospitality includes entertainment expenditure.

The Prime Minister's official hospitality is provided through funding appropriated for State Occasions and Official Visits and Ceremonial Hospitality (CERHOS). For the period 1 July 2010 to 31 May 2011 please refer to the response to question PM131 provided following the 2011-12 Budget Estimates hearings. For the month of June 2011, \$66,552.13 (GST inclusive) was paid through the State Occasions and Official Visits function for the Prime Minister's official hospitality.
