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- a) Yes. ComSuper owns coffee machines for staff use. Two coffee machines have been purchased for select staff usage and for external stakeholders participating in meetings at ComSuper premises. A Jura impressa s9 was purchased in 2008 at a cost of \$2,541 (GST excl) and another Jura impressa x7, was purchased prior to this, for which purchase records are not readily available. ComSuper does not record information in a way that readily allows information specifically related to ongoing costs of consumables for coffee machines to be provided. To attempt to provide this level of detail would involve an unreasonable diversion of departmental resources.
- b) Both machines were purchased, predominately, to service ComSuper's Conference and Board room facilities.
- c) Departmental funds.
- d) ComSuper is responsible for maintenance of the machines. In 2011-12, \$250 (GST incl) was spent on general maintenance, along with \$579 (GST incl) for July September 2012. This was funded from departmental funds.
