Answer

- a) In 2011–12, a total of \$39,900 was spent on recruitment advertising.
 - i. \$11,317 was spent on online advertising; and
 - ii. \$28,583 was spent on print advertising.

The 2011–12 Annual Report (page 96) notes DPS recruitment advertising of \$41,561. The difference between \$41,561 and the \$39,900 reported above is due to the timing of payments, and the change in accounting treatment.
