Senator FAULKNER: ... Can you tell me the name of the 2005 report, please?

Ms Mills: Yes, I can. The report was called *Building facades and finishes*. It was commenced in 2004 and reported in late March 2005, and it was conducted by a company called Diagnostech.

Senator FAULKNER: Thank you.

Ms Mills: The one that I referred to in 1990 was done by Dr Alan Spry, who was the pre- and post-construction stone consultant, and he was engaged by what was then the Joint House Department. I understand that, as an adjunct to the work by Diagnostech, Arup, who are a well-known engineering company, also provided advice on the same issue.

Senator FAULKNER: All right. Thank you. Would it be possible for those three reports to be made available to the committee, please?

Ms Mills: Yes, I believe I can access all of those.

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Senator FAULKNER: In relation to the reports that we mentioned dealing with the building façade, you are able to provide them today to the committee?

Ms Mills: I can certainly provide the Diagnostech report and I will have to provide, as soon as I am able, the report from Dr Spry. I believe there may only be one copy of that. I will have to have some made.
