What are the reasons for taxi costs?

**Answer:**

For this financial year as at 31 October 2012, the National Mental Health Commission has spent \$5,528.44 (ex GST) on taxi costs for the 10 Commissioners and relevant staff to attend Commission meetings, stakeholder meetings and other essential business.

The National Mental Health Commission is a small agency and as such does not record travel data in a disaggregated way by business group. To attempt to provide this level of detail would involve an unreasonable diversion of resources.
