In the rare case that entertainment costs are incurred by PM&C the costs are not recorded separately from official hospitality.

The Prime Minister's official hospitality is provided through administered funding appropriated for State Occasions and Official Visits and Ceremonial Hospitality (CERHOS). For the period 1 July 2012 to 30 September 2012 \$62,595.56 (GST inclusive) was paid for the Prime Minister. Details are provided at Attachment B.

Entertainment provided at official functions hosted by the Prime Minister is also provided through funding appropriated for CERHOS. For the period 1 July 2012 to 30 September 2012, Nil was paid for the Prime Minister's official functions. Details are provided at <u>Attachment B</u>.

PM&C does not allocate budget specifically for official hospitality and entertainment. As events are identified, they are costed and paid for from the existing departmental budget.
