Regarding the release of the new 'Thesaurus of Australian Government Subjects' (TAGS):

- b) Does AUSTRAC have any plans to alter its website or any other publication, electronic or printed, as a result of the release of TAGS?
- c) If so, provide a list of the changes that have been made to the website or any other publication, electronic or printed, as a result of the release of TAGS or if they have not been completed the changes that are planned, and when they are intended to be made?
- d) If not, why not?
- e) Has AUSTRAC distributed TAGS to its staff?
- f) Has AUSTRAC begun using TAGS as a guide to developing its website or any other publication, electronic or printed?
