Senator Ludwig asked the following question at the hearing on 14 February 2006:

Why is the revenue from other sources expected to fall from an actual \$40,920,000 in 2004-05 to \$28,834,000 in 2005-06?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

The change is due to the completion of the draw down of the Commonwealth's \$50 million investment, or seed funding, in CrimTrac in 2004-05. The associated amount of revenue booked in 2004-05 was \$11.546 million, the remainder being the estimated difference in operating results from 2004-05 and 2005-06.
