Senator Ludwig asked the following question at the hearing on 14 February 2006:

When will the TINDAPS schedule of drugs be replaced by the Law and Justice (Serious Drug Offences and Other Measures) Bill?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

The status of the *Crimes (Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances) Act 1990* (TINDAPS) will be reviewed when the schedules of drugs and quantities in the *Criminal Code Act 1995* are amended, which will be done after consideration of the report by the Intergovernmental Committee on Drugs Scheduling Working Party. The IGCDSWP is expected to present its report to the Ministerial Council of Drug Strategy in May 2006.
