#### **Question No. 34**

## Senator Ludwig asked the following question at the hearing on 14 February 2006:

The Document Verification Service – payments to participating agencies:

- a) how much money has been expended?
- b) how much is expected to be spent to 30 June 2006?
- c) if any amount is to be re-apportioned, how much?
- d) will there be a delay in the completion of this project?

### The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

The allocation of funds to the agencies participating in the DVS pilot is contingent upon the construction of certain components of the prototype DVS. As that work is now completed, and Memoranda of Understanding have been signed, we anticipate receiving invoices from the specified agencies in the near future.
