Question No. 131

Senator Ludwig asked the following question at the hearing on 13 February 2007:

Capital Works undertaken by the AFP

- a) provide a list of major capital works projects that the AFP is undertaking?
- b) For the following major Project are AFP able to indicate,
 - i. Were there any additional funds from the starting budget that had been allocated?
 - ii. If they had been allocated how much?
 - iii. What is the expected completion date?
 - iv. Are AFP on target for that completion date? If not, give details.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

- a) As at 9 March 2007 the AFP is currently undertaking the following major capital projects:
 - ANZAC Park West
 - Project Jupiter Stage 2 (Interim Accommodation – Aviation Security)
 - National K9 and Kennelling and Training Facility
 - Australian Institute of Police Management
 - International Deployment Group – Interim Demountable Accommodation.
- b) ANZAC Park West
 - i. Yes.
 - ii. An additional \$26.9m has been allocated on top of the originally approved budget of \$22m.
 - iii. May 2008.
 - iv. Yes.
 - Project Jupiter Stage 2 (Interim Accommodation – Aviation Security)
 - i. No.

 - iii. The last two sites, at Alice Springs and Perth, are due for completion in April 2007 and June 2007 respectively. All other sites are completed.
