Question No. 151

Senator Nettle asked the following question at the hearing on 13 February 2007:

Of the approximately \$156 million in Overseas Development Aid spent annually through the Attorney-General's Department:

- a) What proportion is allocated to the Australian Federal Police?
- b) How much is allocated to:
 - i) Salaries
 - ii) Logistics
 - iii) Overseas accommodation

The answer to the honourable Senator's question is as follows:

a) Total amount allocated to the AFP for the 2005-06 financial year was \$151,733,465.

- b) i) Salary expenses = \$ 42,934,971
- ii) Logistics = \$105,596,859
- iii) Overseas Accommodation = \$ 3,201,635
