Provide statistics on how many hearings a particular matter has.

Answer:

In the period 1 July 2006 to 31 January 2007, hearings were arranged in 2,315 of the 3,340 Migration Review Tribunal cases decided. 54 cases had two or more hearings.

In the period 1 July 2006 to 31 January 2007, hearings were arranged in 1,830 of the 2,012 Refugee Review Tribunal cases decided. 78 cases had two or more hearings.
