Senator Crossin (L&C 27) asked:

I want to take you to an answer to a question you provided to Senator Evans. It was question on notice No. 166. It asked you for a list of the top 150 occupations filled by principal 457 holders. Implicit in his question—or perhaps not so implicit—was that he wanted the numbers by occupation. My request is: could you provide that for us?

You have given us the list of the 150 nominated occupations. You say it is rounded to the nearest 10. We would actually like the numbers per occupation, please.

Answer:

DIAC policy has a strong commitment to ensuring the privacy rights of individual visa holders are not compromised through the collection and publication of statistics. Where statistics are being put into the public domain at a high level of disaggregation and highly private information such as salary levels could potentially be obtained, DIAC policy is to provide rounded figures. This reduces the prospect of individuals' salary levels being inadvertently put into the public domain.

The top 150 nominated occupations of primary applicants granted a subclass 457 visa (excluding Independent Executives and rounded to the nearest 10) in 2005-06 are as follows:
