Given there are only three people on Christmas Island at the moment, what are the staffing numbers there and how many of those are local?

Answer:

Twelve full-time and four part-time staff at Christmas Island Immigration Detention Centre on a shift roster covering 24 hours. All of these staff are locally engaged from the Christmas Island community.
