Senator Ellison asked:

- (1) The Minister for Immigration's office moved from M140 to MG68. Does the department have a breakdown of the costs involved in the move?
- (2) How were items removed from the office, how many staff were required and how much did it cost to rent the vehicles to transport the contents of the old office to the department?
- (3) Where did the contents of the office go in the department?
- (4) Were all of the contents returned?

Answer.

(1) Yes. The total costs attributable to the move from M140 to MG68 are in the order of \$7,800 and principally related to the removal and reinstallation of communications equipment, as outlined below:
