## **Question No. 25**

## Senator Barnett asked the following question at the hearing on 8 February 2010:

Excluding the cascade waterfall, air conditioning and asbestos problems, please provide details of other High Court structural problems and the costs to fix them?

## The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

Following from a public safety risk assessment of the Court precinct, the Court engaged a consulting team to conduct a condition audit and prepare a management plan for the precinct. This management plan was separately costed by a quantity surveyor. The management plan identified 18 items of prime concern and 67 other items.

The Court is in the process of engaging an architectural team to prepare a master plan to address structural problems in the precinct. This may involve a staged approach, with priority being given to problems affecting public safety. Costs of addressing safety concerns are anticipated to exceed \$4 million.
