# (101) Program 4.3: Offshore Asylum Seeker Management

## Senator Humphries asked:

- (1) What is the cost of providing an internet service to detainees at the Christmas Island IDC?
- (2) Is there a cap on how many minutes they use the internet for?
- (3) Are they supervised when using the internet at all times?

#### Answer.

- (1) Approximately \$80,000 per annum. This figure covers IMA client, DIAC staff and contractors (e.g. interpreters, health service provider) usage only. DIAC does not pay for the Detention Service Provider's internet usage.
- (2) Clients are able to book 15 minute timeslots to use the internet facilities at the IDC. Restrictions are not placed on how many timeslots a client can book per day, however clients are encouraged to extend courtesy to other users.
