Senator Cash asked:

What additional staff training is being conducted to bring people into processing and detention roles? At what cost? How many staff involved?

## Answer.

Staff involved in processing and detention roles undertake training specific to their particular roles. Training courses for processing and detention roles are as follows:

- Case Management (Certificate IV)
- Orientation to Case Management
- Entry Interview Training
- Protection Visa/Refugee Status Assessment
- Removals Officers
- Removals Liaison Officers
- Regional Management Team

Table A shows that the number of participants trained has increased from 80 participants in 2007-2008 to 554 participants in 2010 - 31 March 2011:
